Sub : Application for letter of permission for functioning of District Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 55 & 56, Katju Nagar, Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh- 457001 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 06 seats for PG course in 02 subjects with 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica and 03 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26 - regd.

Sir,

District Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 55 & 56, Katju Nagar, Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh- 457001 has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 06 seats for PG course in 02 subjects with 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica and 03 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26. The college has submitted Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted inspection on 27.06.2025 & 28.06.2025, followed by hearing on 16.07.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 & 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty:

In UG: (03 Deficiencies)

- In Department of Physiology 2 Assistant Professor are deficient.
- In Department of Repertory 1 Assistant Professor are deficient.

In PG: (02 Deficiencies)

- In Department of Research Methodology and Biostatistics 1 Professor & 1 Associate Professor are deficient.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 05 teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 50 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college still have deficiency of 01 teachers. However, such relaxed teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.


2. Miscellaneous:

- NABL accreditation is not done.
- Pay scale of all the teaching staff is not according to MES- 2024.

- iii. Yoga department is not available.
 - iv. Skill lab is not available.
 - v. Physiotherapy equipment is not available.
 - vi. OPD & IPD case records are not maintained.
3. Considering the above observation during inspection & hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to District Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, 55 & 56, Katju Nagar, Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh- 457001 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 06 seats for PG course in 02 subjects with 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica and 03 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26** on the basis of following conditions:-
- i. College should apply for NABL within one month of issue of letter.
 - ii. Pay scale of all the teaching staff should be according to MES- 2024 within one month of issue of letter.
 - iii. College should appoint 01 Assistant Professor in Department of Repertory within one month of issue of letter.
 - iv. College should develop yoga department within one month of issue of letter.
 - v. College should develop skill lab within one month of issue of letter.
 - vi. College should make available physiotherapy equipment within one month of issue of letter.
 - vii. College should maintain OPD & IPD case records within one month of issue of letter.
4. All admissions shall be made from NEET/ AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats of BHMS course and 06 seats of MD (Hom.) shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
6. **Conditions under point 3 should be fulfilled within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification to the office, failing which permission for the academic year 2025-26 may be withdrawn.**
